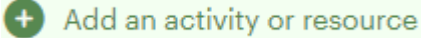


Linking a Leganto reading resource to your course page.

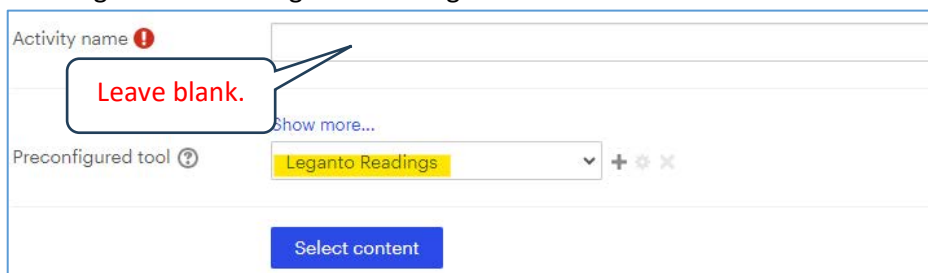
Linking a specific reading from Leganto to Akorara | Learn.

- Navigate to your course page.
- Turn on editing.
- Navigate to the desired section.
- Click 

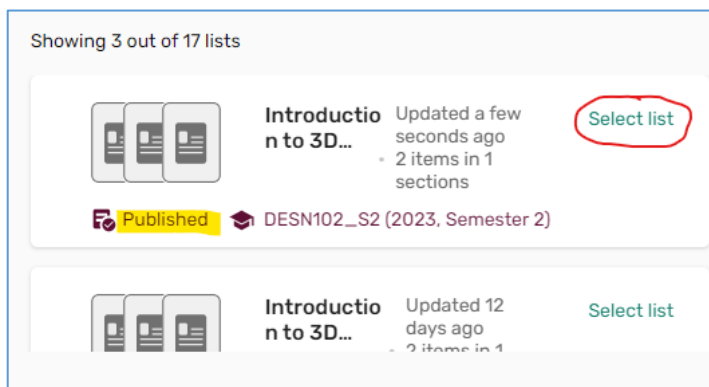
- Add an “External tool”



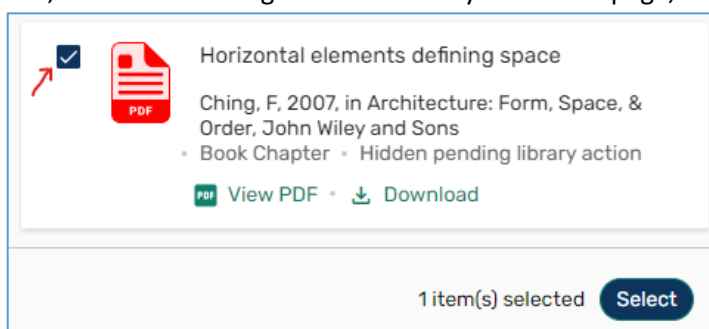
- Select Preconfigured Tool = “Leganto Readings”:



- Leave “Activity name” **blank**, as it will automatically be populated by the name of the reading.
- Click [Select content](#)
- You will be taken to Leganto and a menu of past reading lists. The **current** list will be **on top** with the status of “Published”:

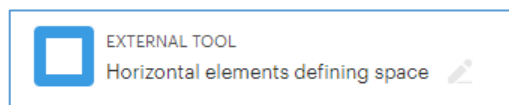


- Click “Select list”
 - If you only see section names, click [Manage sections](#) at the top of the selection box.
- Scroll down, select the reading to be added to your course page, and click “Select”:

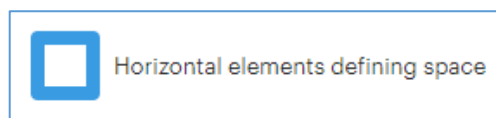


- The resource name will now appear in the ‘Activity name’ box:

- Edit “Activity name” and add author and year (if appropriate)
- Click **Save and return to course** at the bottom of the page.
- Your resource will have been added to your course page:

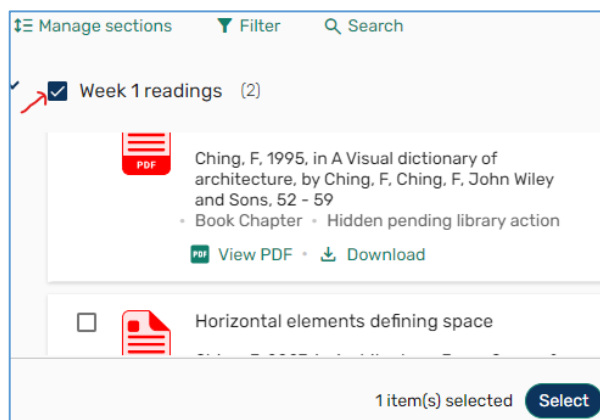


- And in “Student view”:



To add a Leganto section to your course page.

- If you have sections set up in your Leganto reading list, ‘Add an activity or resource’ as above, **but** select the Leganto section:



- The resource name will appear in the “Activity name”:

- Click **Save and return to course** at the bottom of the page.
- All the resources in the chosen Leganto section will be available to student with one click:
